

## Service Referral Agreement

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Chamber of Commerce desires to service the needs of and garner the interest of local retailers and encourage them to participate in local Chamber activities, and .

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Retail Federation represents the retail industry across the state and desires to work with the Chamber of Commerce to encourage retailer participation in local Chamber activities, and

WHEREAS, the Chamber and the KRF seek to increase retailer participation in programs, provide information to retailers to help them become more profitable and build retail membership in both organizations, and

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto, hereby agree as follows:

### SECTION 1

#### Responsibilities

- 1.1 The Chamber and KRF agree that whenever possible, each party will work together for the purpose of advancing each other's membership goals.
- 1.2 KRF will provide services to the Chamber including but not limited to providing retail specific legislative and regulatory information, issue briefings, retail industry news feeds and industry trends and updates, communications services, make presentations to members regarding retail related issues and help in the formation of a "Retail Merchants Council."
- 1.3 The Chamber will market KRF services as a member benefit to members. Likewise, KRF will promote local Chamber activities to its members.
- 1.4 The Chamber agrees that it must be a member in good standing in the Kentucky Chamber of Commerce Executives Association (KCCE) in order for this agreement to remain in effect.

## **ATTACHMENT A**

The Chamber and KRF hereby agree to the following:

1. Chamber Associate Member dues shall be payable to KRF according to the following schedule:
  - A. Chambers with annual dues income less than \$150,000 shall pay dues of \$180 per year.
  - B. Chambers with annual dues income between \$150,001 - \$500,000 shall pay dues of \$280 per year.
  - C. Chambers with annual dues income more than \$500,000 shall pay dues of \$380 per year.
